Many Jewish pilgrims who come to Jerusalem for the first time stop in our little town to recite the Sh'hecheyanu (the blessing for doing something new). Mevasseret derives its name from the prophet Isaiah, who long ago must have stopped at the then-barren mountaintop and admired King David's walled city. His prophecy is read on August 5th as the haftarah of the Shabbat Nachamu (Shabbat of Consolation). From Isaiah 40:9:
